

THE MADRAS CORPORATION EDUCATIONAL
SERVICES RULES, 1970

(G.O. Ms. No. 243, Rural Development and Local Administration
dated 18th February 1970)

1. *Short Title* . — These rules may be called the Madras Corporation Educational Services Rules.

2. *Constitution* . — This Service shall consist of the following classes and categories of officers : —

CLASS I-A	
Educational Officer	
CLASS II	
Category 1	Assistant Educational Officer
Category 2	Head Master or Head Mistress (Grade I)

3. *Appointment* . — Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the methods

specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:—

CLASS I-A.	
Educational Officer	(i) By promotion from categories I and 2 in class II or (ii) By appointment from among the holders of the posts of District Educational Officers or headmasters and Headmistresses in the Madras Educational Service on deputation basis
CLASS II.	
Category - I Assistant Educational Officer	(i) By promotion from the categories of B.T. Supervisors, B.T. Headmasters (Grade II) and B.T. Assistants (Grade I and II) in the Corporation Educational Subordinate Service; or (ii) By appointment from among holders of the posts of Deputy Inspectors of Schools, Schools Assistants, Head Masters and Head mistresses Grades I and II in the Madras Educational Subordinates Service on deputation basis.
Category - 2 Headmasters and Headmistress Grade I	(i) By promotion from the categories of B.T. Supervisors B.T. Head masters (Grade II) and B.T. Assistants (Grade I and II) in the Corporation Educational Subordinate Service (ii) By appointment from among holders of the posts of Deputy Inspectors of Schools, School Assisants, Headmasters or Head-mistress, Grade I and II in the Madras Educational Subordinate Services on deputation basis.

4. *Qualifications* .— No persons shall be eligible for appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below unless the possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof :—

1. Educational Officer	(i) B.A. or B.Sc. degree of a recognised University or Institution; (ii) B.T. degree of a recognised University or Institution. (iii) Experience for a period of not less than two years as Assistant Educational Officer in the case of those other than District Educational Officer in the Madras Educational Service appointed on Deputation basis; and (iv) A pass in the Account Test for Subordinate Officers parts I and II or any similar test prescribed by the Government.
2. Assistant Educational Officer.	(i) B.A. or B.Sc. Degree of a recognised University or Institution; (ii) B.T. Degree of a recognised University or Institution; and (iii) Experience for a period of not less than five years as B.T. Supervisor or Headmaster or Headmistress (Grade-II) in the Corporation Educational Subordinate Service/Headmaster or Headmistress or Deputy Inspector of Schools Grade I in Madras Educational Subordinate Service; or Experience for a period of not less than twelve years as B.T. Assistant (Grades I and II) in the Corporation Educational Subordinate Service / School Assistants or Deputy Inspector of Schools Grade II in the Madras Educational Subordinate Service; and (iv) A pass in the Account Test for Subordinate Officers parts I and II or any similar test prescribed by the Government

3. Head master or Head-mistress Grade I.	<p>(i) B.A. or B.Sc., Degree of a recognised University or Institution;</p> <p>(ii) B.T. Degree of a recognised University or Institution; and</p> <p>(iii) Experience for a period of not less than five years as B.T. Supervisor or Headmaster or Headmistress (Grade-II) in the Corporation Educational Subordinate Service / Headmaster or Headmistress or Deputy Inspector of Schools Grade I in the Madras Educational Subordinate Service; or</p> <p>Experience for a period of not less than ten years as B.T. Assistants (Grades I and II) in the Corporation Educational Subordinate Service / Schools Assistants or Deputy Inspector of School Grade II in the Madras Educational Subordinate Service.</p>

Explanation . — For the purpose of this rule, a recognised University or Institution shall mean any University or institution recognised by the University Grants Commission for purpose of its grant.

5. *Probation* . — A person appointed to any of the class or categories shall from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

6. *Posting and Transfers* . — Posting and transfers of officers included in Class I-A shall be made by the State Government and that of officers included in Class II by the Commissioner, Corporation of Madras.

7. *Pay* . — There shall be paid to the holders of the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below, from the Municipal fund a monthly pay calculated in the scale specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof or in the scales of pay that may be determined by the State Government from time to time.

I. Educational Officer	Rs. 550 - 50 - 850 plus the usual allowances admissible.
II. Assistant Educational Officer	Rs. 300 - 15 - 375 - 25 - 550 plus the usual allowances admissible.
III. Headmaster or Headmistress (Grade I)	Rs. 300 - 15 - 450 plus the usual allowances admissible.

8. *Conveyance allowance* . — There shall be paid to the holders of the post of Educational Officer and Assistant Educational Officer a conveyance allowance at such rates and subject to such conditions as may be determined by the State Government from time to time. The conveyance allowance paid to the holders of the posts shall be met from the Municipal fund.

9. *Pension and Provident Fund* . — (1) Members of this service shall be governed by the Madras Liberalised Pension Rules, General Provident Fund (Madras) Rules and Madras Family Pension Rules, as adopted by the Corporation of Madras.

(2) Members of the Corporation Service who opted to remain under any pensionary scheme in the Corporation of Madras shall continue to remain under such scheme.

10. *Savings* . — Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect any person holding any of the referred to in these rules on the date of coming into force of these rules.
